Join us on May 27, 2026, as we celebrate the Feast of the Consistory, one of the most significant observances in Scottish Rite Masonry.

May 31 is traditionally recognized as the day on which the Scottish Rite was formally established as an organized Masonic body in Charleston, South Carolina, in 1801. It is also associated with the historic "Manifesto," or *Circular Throughout the Two Hemispheres*, through which that founding was proclaimed to the wider Masonic world.

This observance is more than a date of historical importance. It is an opportunity to reflect on the enduring work of the Consistory and on the teachings of the 31° and 32° Degrees: self-examination, fidelity to truth, and the continual pursuit of moral and spiritual perfection. In Scottish Rite thought, the Consistory marks the culmination of that journey, reminding us that the Royal Secret is

not simply conferred, but must be expressed through service, character, and devotion to humanity.

The Feast will be held during dinner, and as part of the evening's educational program, Brother Keith Willford, 32°, KSA, will present the 17°, Knight of the East and West. Although not a Consistory degree, the 17° is a philosophical degree that explores the transition from the old to the new, the pursuit of truth, and steadfast loyalty to God.

Please join us for an evening of fellowship, reflection, and inspiration as we honor the Feast of the Consistory and the rich heritage of the Scottish Rite. On this special occasion, we gather not only to remember the formal beginning of the Rite, but also to renew our own commitment to its principles, its teachings, and the bonds that unite us as Brethren.
